

Optimism May Help Women Stay Mobile in Older Age

Optimistic older women are found to maintain some physical abilities better as they age, according to Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health researchers. A study of nearly 6,000 women aged over 65 as they were tested at four different time points over six years revealed that those with a positive outlook experienced a slower decline in mobility. Furthermore, it was found that more positive people may be better protected against the inflammatory damage of stress..
